

Default application launch after updating from CCpilot VC OS 1.0.0.0 to 1.1.0.0

When updating from OS version *1.0.0.0* to *1.1.0.0* one might end up in a situation where two instances of *StartupLauncher GUI* are started on boot. This is due to boot time optimization, we start the GUI from */opt/etc/rc3.d/S04* currently. This issue can be fixed by performing factory reset (`reboot-rescue.sh clear`), or by removing the *S20StartupLauncherGUI* script from */opt/etc/rc3.d/*. If the GUI is not to be started at all, place `exit`-command to the beginning of */opt/etc/rc3.d/StartupLauncherGUI* file.
